

AircraftConversions Delivers Third Fokker50Freighter.

The first of an order for five Fokker50Freighter conversions was delivered today to MiniLiner of Bergamo, Italy at Centennial Airport, Denver, Colorado, USA.

“A dispatch reliability of almost 100% on the freighter conversion so far, the fit in the 6-8 tonne kg cargo segment with 60 cubic meter, with a loadability up to 488 kgs per square meter and with a good payload / range capability has made the Fokker50Freighter already a proven workhorse in our fleet”. Says Giuseppe Berlusconi, CEO of MiniLiner.

Two Fokker50Freighters are owned by MiniLiner since end 2007 and have been operating in Europe since early 2008; one for MiniLiner and the other one for Amapola

The next MiniLiner Fokker50 in passenger configuration will enter the freight conversion process in February 2009 at AircraftConversion's new Installation Center at Front Range Airport, Denver, Colorado, USA.

AircraftConversions, with its FAA and EASA certificated freighter concept, is the sole company authorized to do the freighter conversions on the entire Fokker50PropJet fleet.

With the recent orders the number of freight conversions is ten with five options and a backlog of seven.
